

Adam Szejnfeld - lawyer, former "Solidarność" Trade Union activist, imprisoned in Wronki and Gębarzewo. Entrepreneur, councillor and mayor. Vice President of the Wielkopolska Centre for Education and Local Government Studies in Poznań. Former Member of the Polish Parliament for five terms, during which he chaired the Economic Committee, Treasury Committee, Deregulation Committee. Deputy Minister of Economy and head of the Government's Anti-Crisis Committee. Author of the pro-development "Szejnfeld's Package", the largest in recent years set of bills deregulating Polish administrative and economic law. This legislative package is best known for replacing the culture of certificates with the culture of statements and introducing presumption of taxpayer honesty. Columnist writing for printed press as well as Internet portals. Multiple winner of the "Man of the Year" Prize awarded by journalists of the Wielkopolska region. One of the top ten Polish politicians according to *Polityka*, a weekly newsmagazine; winner of the "Bona Lex" Prize awarded by *Gazeta Prawna*, a legal newspaper. Currently Member of the European Parliament, active in three committees: Internal Market and Consumer Protection (IMCO), International Trade (INTA) and Development (DEVE). Member of the Civic Platform, in the EP belonging to the European People's Party (EPP).
